Safe Church Policy

The Children's and Youth department (C&Y) is charged with making Plymouth a safe place for all youth, children, and C&Y volunteers. Safe Church compliance means we seek to make sure there are satisfactory safeguards in place for any program involving our young people. This is a list of the rules set in place to make sure Plymouth is a safe place for all our children and young people.

- Our nursery has two professional childcare providers who have been fully background checked and trained in "Safe Church" practices.
- Only approved parents or guardians may sign children in and out in the nursery.
- Our Sunday School teachers and Youth Group volunteers are each asked to fill out a disclosure form, give a reference, and, as a precaution, their names are checked against the national database of sex offenders and must pass a background check.
- Our Sunday School classroom doors have windows, and whenever possible, we have at least two unrelated adults present in classes, especially in classes with young children.
- For youth group events, we always make sure to have two unrelated adults present from the time the first teen arrives to the moment the last teen is picked up.
- For times when the two adult rule cannot be supported, at least three individuals (one must be an adult) will be present during church-related activities. An adult will never be left alone with a child or youth.
- Adult volunteers must have attended Plymouth Church regularly for at least 6 months before working with children or youth in a leadership role.
- All persons working with minors must be at least five years older than the age group they are leading/supervising.
- We have a procedure in place for Incidents of Suspected Abuse.
- For outings we require parents or guardians to fill out permission slips indicating that their child has permission to join all events scheduled for that year.
